Interoperability in Europe



Limited interoperability of services and data of public administrations



Inefficient governance of interoperability efforts between EU policies, the Commission and Member States for all administrative levels and sectors.



Lack of common minimum interoperability specifications, shared solutions, standards.



Lack of an 'interoperability-by-default' approach in the design and implementation of EU and MS's legislation and policies.

European Interoperability Framework

Technical interoperability

Ensures the effective linking of systems and services via infrastructures and applications

- Use of open standards and specifications

Semantic interoperability

Ensures that the precise format and meaning of exchanged data and information is preserved and understood throughout exchanges between parties

- Use of core vocabularies

Legal interoperability

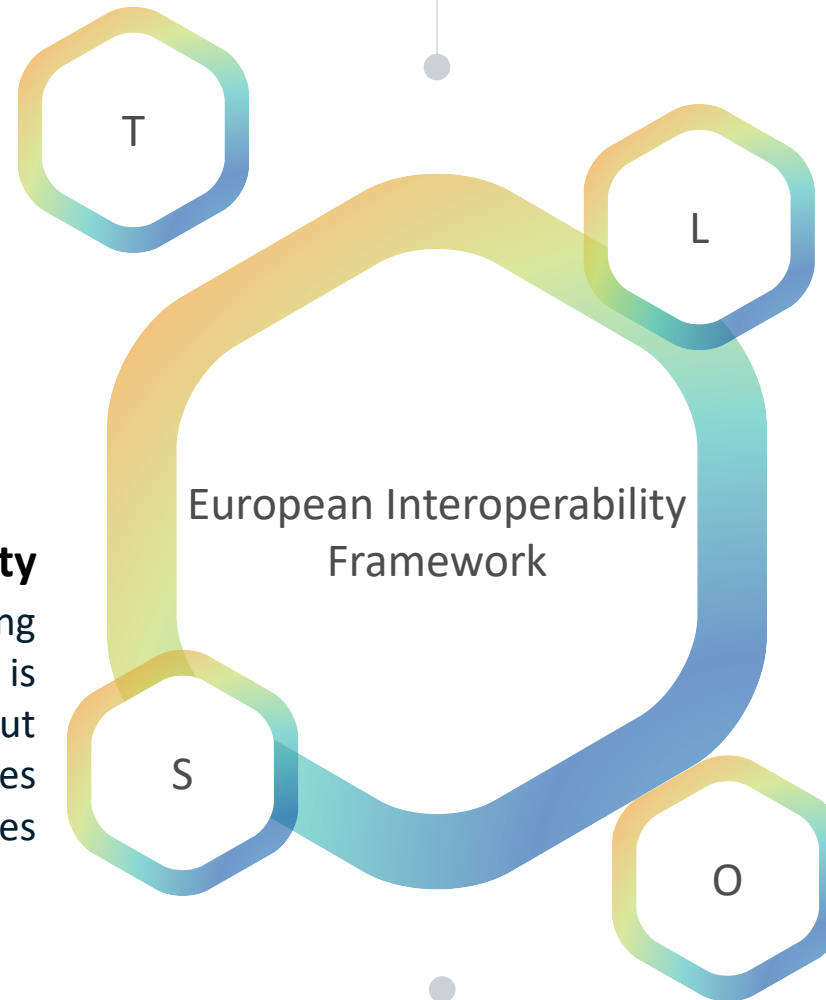
Ensuring that organisations operating under different legal frameworks, policies and strategies are able to work together

- Clear agreements

Organisational interoperability

Align business processes, responsibilities and expectations to implement, manage or provide digital public services

- Memorandum of Understanding

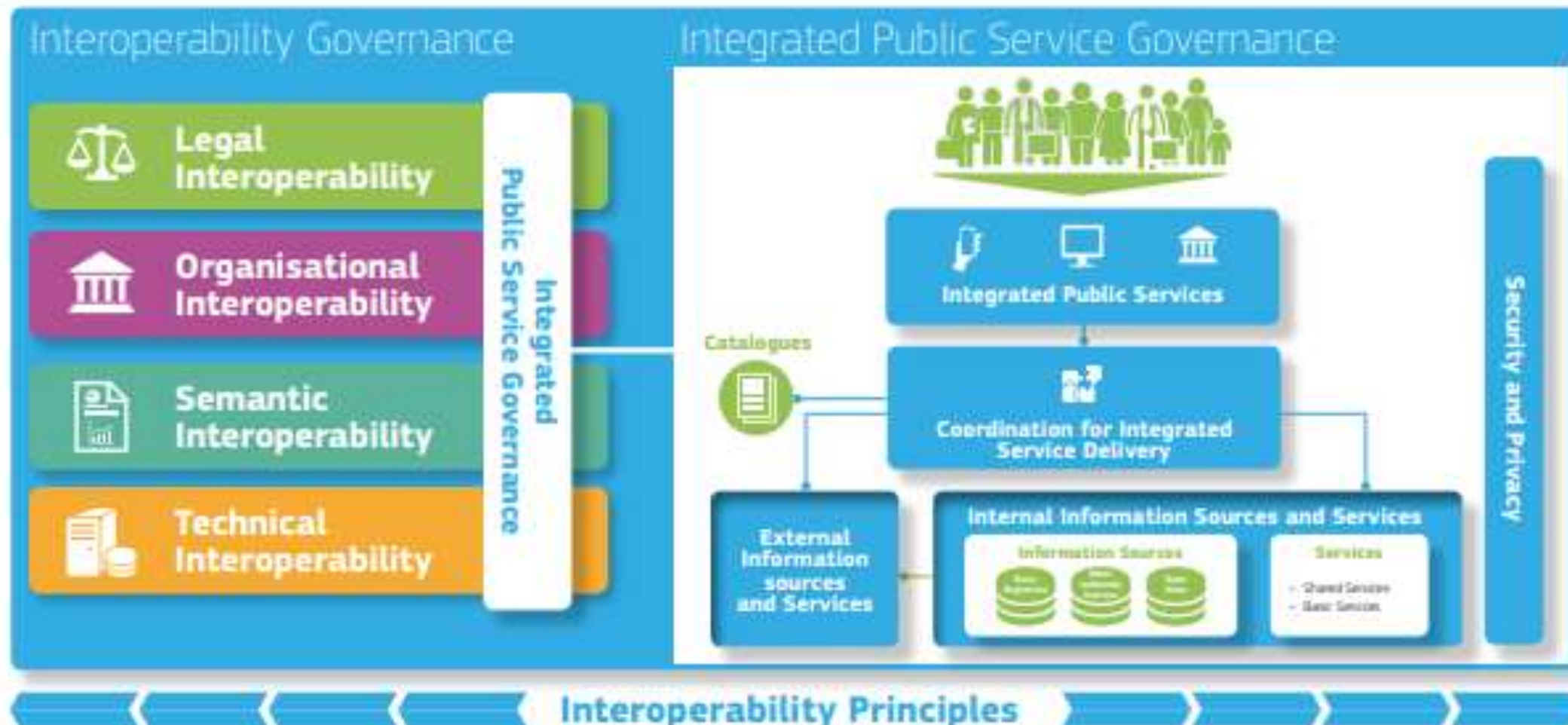

Governments

Co-owned EU-level governance to help build a secure cross-border exchange of data and agree on shared interoperability solutions.

Businesses

Enabling businesses to seamlessly operate in the Digital Single Market.

Catalyst for innovation ecosystem actors to engage in technology based GovTech cooperation to modernize and transform service delivery.

Who we help

The Interoperable Europe Act's objective is to assist the EU and Member States to deliver public services, which are interoperable by default, across borders for citizens and businesses

Citizens

Ensuring that every European, regardless of their location, has access to digital public services without discrimination.

Innovation Ecosystem (GovTech Focus)

Enabling stakeholders from across the EU to contribute to enhanced cross-border interoperability and the related solutions through the Interoperable Europe Community.

Interoperable Europe Act in a nutshell

Helps EU and Member State administrations to deliver connected digital services to citizens and businesses across Europe.

What? Digital public services and their systems

All services requiring cross-border data exchange in EU.

Why? Better public services

Assess interoperability before binding decisions.

Who? Union entities and public sector bodies

All entities that provide or manage digital public services.

When? Entered into force in April 2024

Full application from 12 January 2025.
