<b>Call Modules and topics</b>	All call modules
<b>Proposal submission</b>	The pre-proposal and the full proposal have also to be submitted on our own <a href="#">portal</a> by our “regional partner”. The pre-proposal can be in English. If selected for presenting a full proposal, it must be in French AND English.
<b>Project Consortium Partners</b>	<p>The following are eligible according to the rules of SPW:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Universities, Research Centers, SME, large companies, settled in Wallonia, in case of industrial research (TRL 3 to 5)</li> <li>only SMEs and large companies settled in Wallonia in case of experimental development (TRL 6 to 7 (8))</li> <li>other companies or NGOs only for promotion activities in both industrial research (TRL 3 to 5) and experimental development (TRL 6 to 7 (8))</li> </ul> <p><b>The consortium must include at least one industrial partner with an operational headquarters located in Wallonia as of the proposal submission date. The research budget of the Walloon partner company or companies must represent at least 40% of the total budget of all Walloon partners.</b></p>

<b>Other requirements/guidelines</b>	<b>The partners in Wallonia MUST give a pdf file from their 2024 balance published on Banque Nationale de Belgique (mandatory)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The project cannot receive double funding; a specific form has to be filled in.</li> <li>• The budget for the Walloon partners should follow the SPW-EER (DGO6) cost model.</li> <li>• The funding rate will be the maximum allowed by the decree of the 3rd of July 2008, modified.</li> <li>• The beneficiary must have a stable financial situation; A financial viability check has to be carried out before being recommended for full proposal.</li> <li>• The beneficiary must have Operational offices in the Walloon Region.</li> <li>• The project must add benefit to the regional economy.</li> <li>• All information needed for evaluation should be available.</li> </ul>
