Proposal submission	Applicants who want to apply for funding from JUNTAEX must contact <b>cetp@fundecyt-pctex.es</b> as soon as the consortium is complete and before the pre-proposal submission, but latest <b>3 working days</b> before the deadline (9 October 2025).
	After the selection of full proposals, JUNTAEX will implement an assignation procedure with the regional applicant to determine the reporting and payment process of the grants.
	JUNTAEX will coordinate with the other Spanish funders for the efficient use of the resources allocated to Extremaduran entities.

The projects granted under this call must comply with the European <b>Do No</b> <b>Significant Harm (DNSH) principle</b> .
