Proposal submission	<p>Applicants who want to apply for funding from JUNTAEX must contact cetp@fundecyt-pctex.es as soon as the consortium is complete and before the pre-proposal submission, but latest 3 working days before the deadline (9 October 2025).</p> <p>After the selection of full proposals, JUNTAEX will implement an assignation procedure with the regional applicant to determine the reporting and payment process of the grants.</p> <p>JUNTAEX will coordinate with the other Spanish funders for the efficient use of the resources allocated to Extremaduran entities.</p>
